

### *iii) New Collections/Additions*

The Archives receives numerous gifts each year. This year, gifts received included:

**a) *Papers of Jo Freeman*:** Jo Freeman is a political activist and one of the founders of the Women's Liberation Movement. This collection highlights her advocacy in human rights and politics. There are pamphlets, notes, press releases, and newspaper articles documenting her involvement with the Brooklyn Women's Political Caucus, Brooklyn Independent Democrats, Kings County Democratic Committee, and neighborhood community board.

**b) *Papers of the Nottingham Association*:** This collection was donated by Helen Rosen, the Association's recording secretary. This neighborhood association hoped to "develop and implement crime prevention programs and to promote mutual and general welfare of the community."

**c) *Collection of Jack Fox*:** Fox was a boxing aficionado; this collection was donated by his daughter Rosanne Fox. This small collection contains boxing memorabilia including photographs and programs dating from the 1950s.

**d) *Collection of Shirley Dinhofer*:** Dinhofer was the administrator who ran President Hess' Museum of the Borough of Brooklyn. She donated 15 boxes plus oversized prints related to this now defunct Museum's activities.

**e) *Collection of Yustin Sirutis*:** Yustin Sirutis was an amateur boxer in the late 1920s and early 1930s. This small collection was donated by his wife in 2012 and contains items such as a Golden Gloves Champion robe, photographs, medals, coins, and a ring.

**f) *Wolfe Institute Materials*:** The Library received 12 boxes of audio visual materials. The tapes vary: there are topics covering RICO Laws and civil liberties, privacy, the Internet, multilingual America, stuttering, and poetry readings.

**g) *Papers of Judge Emily Jane Goodman*:** We received 40 more boxes related to her professional endeavors.

**h) *Dershowitz Collection Additions*:** 44 additional boxes of materials were received including documents related to his court cases and his classes at Harvard. In addition, we have received materials relating to his forthcoming autobiography *Taking the Stand*.

**i) *William Alfred Collection Additions*:** The additions include memorabilia and artwork owned by the BC alum and playwright William Alfred. Most notably is a poster from the Dublin premier of his award winning play about the Irish American experience entitled *Hogan's Goat*.
